LIVING STONES

The site of the Abbey of Villers-la-Ville, which dates back to 1146, is about a ten-minute drive from where we live and has become a special place for our family to visit. Imagining life during the 12th century is a bit of a stretch for us when we realize that Columbus sailed to the New World 350 years later! At one point, this vast compound housed over 400 monks and laymen, but unfortunately, centuries of neglect have left the buildings in ruins and totally unlivable .

By contrast, we are LIVING STONES, part of a "sanctuary vibrant with life (2 Peter 4-The Message)." God is calling us to be models of His love and life to others so that they too can become building blocks of the Kingdom of God. This often *involves a major time investment on our part, but we know that the Holy Spirit is at work in the lives and hearts of many people around us, with lasting results!*

Marie came to faith while on an exchange program in the US. We've had the privilege of getting to know her in the past few months and have had opportunities to further equip her in her walk with the Lord, namely training her to help lead the *Students for Christ* group in the city of Namur. She has been a light in this nation, and God is using her to draw other Belgians into a relationship with Him.

Blair recently spent the afternoon walking and praying with a Harvard grad who is in the process of learning about faith in Christ. **N. grew up as the son of a diplomat and had everything money and education could buy,** but in his words, he was emotionally bankrupt. He became friends with a former SFC leader when they both worked for the same company, and as a result he is finding his place in the family of God.

God is at work, molding and shaping building blocks that will fit well together and serve the purpose for which they were created. And with Him as the builder, this living sanctuary will not only exist for generations to come, but for all eternity!
